

# NOTICE OF WORKS ON NON-SCHEDULED WATERS

## Queen Elizabeth Way (QEW) Credit River Bridge Improvement Project, City of Mississauga, Region of Peel

The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for public comment described herein and its site and plans.

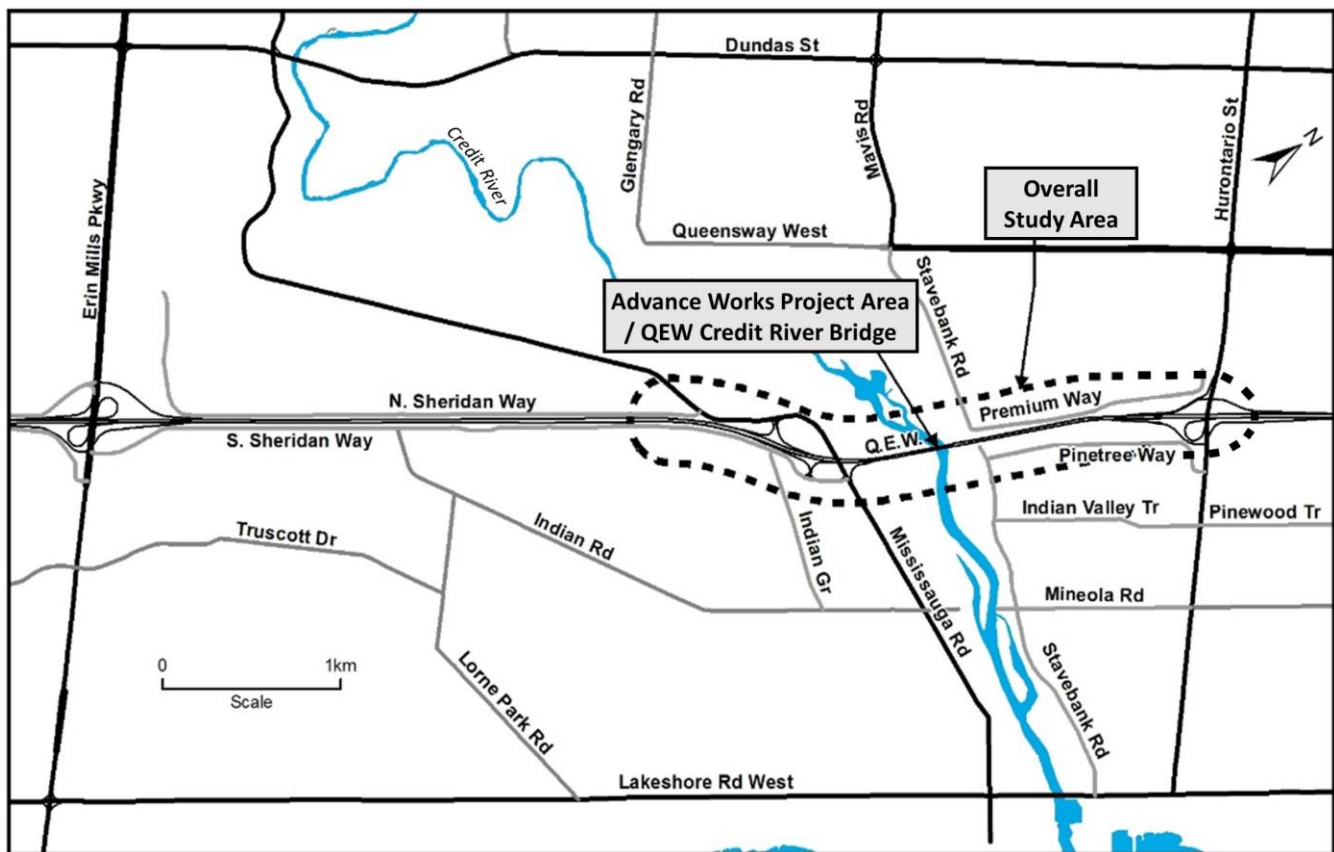
Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act, MTO has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 1658, a description of the following work, its site and plans.

### THE PROJECT

The Ministry of Transportation (MTO) has identified a strategy to accommodate future transportation requirements for the QEW from west of Mississauga Road to west of Hurontario Street, including the addition of a new QEW Credit River Twin Bridge directly to the north of the existing bridge. In advance of the bridge design and construction, MTO is undertaking advance works for the project in the Credit River Valley, as noted in the figure below. The proposed works include:

- Site preparation (access, protective fencing, etc.)
- Temporary cofferdams at each river bank to facilitate marine archaeology in the Credit River
- Supplementary utility works in the Credit River valley, within the limits of the cofferdams

The works are expected to have minimal impacts to navigation of the Credit River.
