Construction Milestones

## CONSTRUCTION YEAR IN REVIEW

**EDCO** – Happy to report that the team has reached several important milestones.

### SPRING 2024

- The removal of the centre portion of the existing QEW bridge deck, was completed in February 2024 with the first deck slab poured in late March 2024.

### NOVEMBER 2023

- The QEW Westbound on-ramp from Mississauga Road.

### SEPTEMBER 2023

- Start of the demolition and rehabilitation of the existing QEW Credit River bridge.

### JULY 2023

- The team celebrated the opening of the new QEW twin bridge.
- The work at Kenollie Creek-Premium Way was complete.

### JUNE 2023

- The storm water management pond at Stavebank-Premium Way was completed.

### MAY 2023

- Start of construction for the North-South Pedestrian-Cyclists Crossing at Stavebank Road, both north and south of the QEW.

### JANUARY 2023

- The girder installation for the new QEW Credit River bridge was completed.

## PROJECT ELEMENTS



- Construction of a new QEW twin bridge north of the existing Credit River Bridge.
- Rehabilitation of the existing QEW Credit River Bridge.
- Replacement of the QEW - Mississauga Road overpass.
- Improvements and reconfiguration of the QEW -Mississauga Road interchange.
- Construction of a new multi-use trail that will cross the Credit River linking the existing trail.
- Construction of a new pedestrian bridge over the QEW at Stavebank Road.

- 2.6 km of highway improvements.
- Over 100 unionized trade workers.

**2023 YEAR IN REVIEW**



**JANUARY:** The girders are installed for the New QEW Credit River Bridge – looking at the underside.



**MAY:** The foundation work for the North-South Pedestrian-Cyclist Crossing at Premium Way.



**JUNE:** The stormwater management pond at Stavebank Road-Premium Way completed.



**JUNE:** Installation of the bridge clear noise wall panels.



**JULY:** Premium Way and Kenollie Creek work completed.



**JULY:** New bridge opening celebration.

**AUGUST:** A dragon boat crew inspecting the work.



**SEPTEMBER:** Existing QEW bridge substructure bracing, the first step in the bridge rehabilitation.



**SEPTEMBER:** The start of the removal of the existing QEW bridge deck.



**NOVEMBER:** Opened up the QEW westbound on-ramp from Mississauga Road.



**FEBRUARY:** Phase 1: Demolition and removal of the existing QEW bridge deck.



**MARCH:** Existing QEW bridge, first concrete pour for the new deck.
